

Science Brainwaves does Dragon's Den – Rules:

- 1) 500 word event summary must be submitted by Tuesday 1st November 2011, you will be informed if you have secured a place at 'pitch night' by Monday 7th November
- 2) Winning summaries must present a 5 minute pitch to our expert panel of judges on Tuesday 22nd November and be prepared to answer a few questions afterwards. (Projection equipment will be available on the night!)
- 3) The event will be a 'Science Brainwaves' event – this means that it must be branded with our logos, use our website/facebook/twitter for promotion
- 4) Science Brainwaves will be named/logos used in ALL promotional material
- 5) The event must have the broad theme of 'Our World in Motion'
- 6) Although the responsibility for the event lies with the 'Event Submitter', a Science Brainwaves committee member will need to be kept fully informed of progress of the event, this includes being present at all meetings about the event where possible and will have the final say in any decisions that affect the reputation of Science Brainwaves
- 7) Science Brainwaves reserves the right to remove its financial and managing committee support at any point if we feel that the event no longer promotes the organisation correctly, or if the event fails to reach our high standards, or if the event does not meet the organisations aims.
- 8) All costs incurred for the event will need to be approved by the Science Brainwaves treasurer; Adam Croucher, a.croucher@sciencebrainwaves.com
- 9) The financial support WILL NOT be released directly to the 'Event Submitter', all costs must go through the Science Brainwaves treasurer.
- 10) The event must be completed preferably during March 2012 to coincide with National Science and Engineering week, but at the latest, must be completed by April 2012.
